## A SMALL SEMANTIC REMINDER

## VHC (Véhicule Historique de Compétition, aka Historic Racing Vehicle) :

• The crew's position is determined by the time realized in the special stages.

## Are eligible:

- Historic competition vehicles from 1947 to 1985 with an Historical Technical Passport
- Vehicles of the group « Classic of competition » from 1977 to 1981 with 3 parts passport
- Competition vehicles of the J2 period (1986 to 1990) with an HTP

## VHRS (Véhicule Historique de Régularité Sportive, aka Historic Sports Regularity Vehicle):

• Average speeds are determined at the beginning of a special stage. There are three different average speeds: high, intermediate, low. The goal is be as close from the average speed as possible.

### Are eligible:

• Vehicles from 1947 to 1990, 4 averages to choose (High, Intermediate, Low, Reduced)

### **LEGEND**

• This category was created to allow gentlemen drivers who wished to take part in our event to enjoy the atmosphere and itinerary of a major historic rally without stopwatch.




## AN INTERNATIONAL HISTORIC RALLY



## THE 2019 TOUR DE CORSE HISTORIQUE

The Tour's new route will take the competitors directly from the sea to the mountain in just a few minutes, over peaks 1200m high and through an array of landscapes that make Corsica renowned all over the world. From Monday, October 5th to Saturday, October 10th, the Tour de Corse Historique will once again push the pilots to their limits, but the race will again and mainly focus on the thrill of driving!

## On the agenda:

- An unprecedented route following some of the legendary special stages from the Tour de Corse.
- A day of show and ride to warm up the riders, the machines and the pleasure of the public.
- A four days competition : a total of 1046km (650mi) for the crews with 4 special stages a day on average.
- A closing ceremony will conclude the week in the most enjoyable way.
